Through her work, Howse captures the ephemeral nature of existence, intertwining the past and present in an ever-evolving tapestry of visual experience.

Iwona Blazwick's curatorial text articulates the essence of Howse's artistic exploration, noting that her pieces evoke a range of emotional and sensory responses. From the delicate, pastel hues reminiscent of Japanese watercolours to the vigorous compositions of pure abstraction, each work is a testament to Howse's mastery in balancing intimacy with epic scale.
