Pi Artworks London Presents: Resonance A Solo Exhibition by Ayten Turanli





Notable exhibitions include the 6th International Biennale for Ceramics in Cairo (2002), "Art Colony" at Gallery Helena in Halkidiki, Greece (2008), her solo presentation at Collect, Somerset House London (2020), her solo exhibition "Cobblestones" at Pi Artworks Istanbul (2010), and the presentation of the "Dissimilar Series" at Pi Artworks in London (2023).
