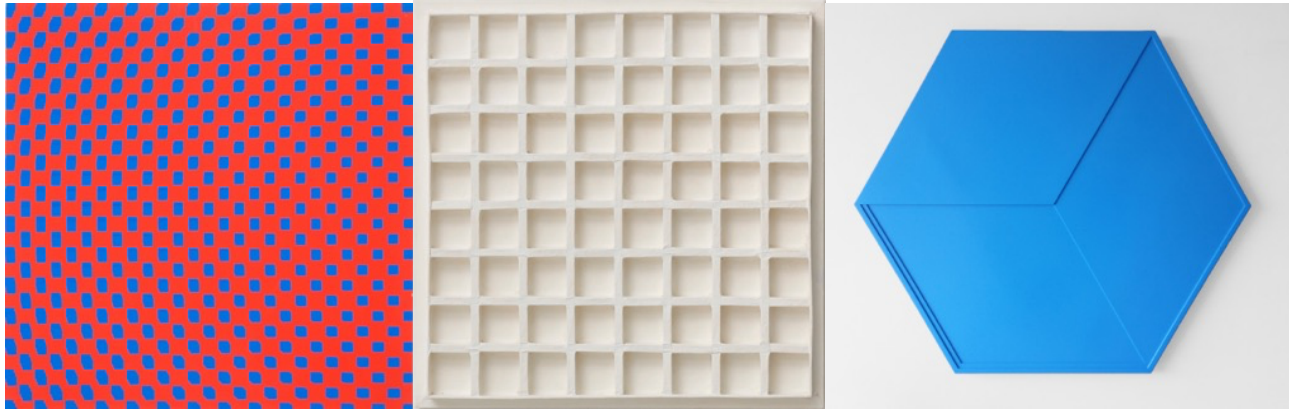


# THE MAYOR GALLERY
